Dear Fellow Karate-Ka,

This year our 3rd CKC Symposium will take a detailed look at **The New ISKF Tournament and Regulations Book**. This is with the aim of increasing the pool of qualified judges in the Caribbean as well as to improve the quality and confidence of judges in the ISKF Caribbean.

The new rulebook has some new concepts and rules. With this in mind all judges **must** attend this Symposium. All Black Belts 16 years and older will be required to judge during the eliminations. Therefore, all black belts **16 years** and over who will be judging **must** attend this course, even if they do not have judge's qualifications. This will ensure that we all are kept abreast and up to date with the latest developments.

The Examinations will be conducted by Sensei Frank Woon-A-Tai, 8th Dan ISKF.

Youth Division

Qualification

1. Junior Individual participation shall be **unlimited**.
2. Junior girls and boys must be ranked ISKF brown and black belt.
3. Their ages at the time of the CKC karate championships **must** be between the ages **7** to **17** years.
4. All juniors **must** be ISKF members in good standing. An ISKF Membership Card with the pertinent information **must** be submitted at registration.
5. Junior team kata is also **unlimited** Members **must** be within the age range of the specific category. In the event that a country wishes to submit a team with members of different categories, they shall compete in the age range of the **oldest** member.
6. **No** mixed teams allowed (combination of girls & boys)
7. The top four (4) girls and the top four (4) boys from each age division for both kata and kumite will advance to the finals.
8. The **top four (4)** girls' team and the **top four (4)** boys' team from each age division will advance to the finals.

Individual and Team Kata Rules

1. All **individual elimination** matches will be judged by the flag system, until the semi-finals eight competitors, using the following **Shitei Kata: Heian Nidan, Heian Sandan, Heian Yondan, Heian Godan, Tekki Shodan**.
2. The **individual semi-finals eight contestants** will be judged by flag system, until the final four competitors, using the following **Sentei Kata: Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Empi, Jion**.
3. The **final four** constants will be judged by point system with the contestants' choice of: **Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Empi, Jion, Jitte, Hangetsu or Gankaku**. **However, junior black belts only, may perform any kata**.
4. In the case of a **tie in individual or team kata**, a different kata **must** be performed. If the rematch is tied again, the **lowest** score will be added. If the result is still tied, the **highest** score will be added. If deadlocked, a **third different kata** must be performed.
5. In **team kata**, if **one or more members are brown belts**, the team is **limited** to the performance of the following katas: **Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Empi, Jion, Jitte, Hangetsu or Gankaku**. **Black belt** teams may perform any kata of their choice.
6. In the **team kata finals**, the same kata used in the eliminations may be performed again.

Individual Kumite Rules

1. All contestants **must** have their own mouth guards and white sparing gloves.
 2. For girls & boys aged **7 – 9** and **10 – 11**, the following individual elimination matches, until the **final four**, is applied: **Kihon Ippon Kumite** (basic one step sparring) using **right attacks only**(starting from left gedan-barai) – Jodan Oi-zuki, Chudan Oi-Zuki, Chudan Mae-geri, Chudan Yoko-geri Kekomi. Red side (aka) attacks first and must complete all four attacks. Thereafter, white side (shiro) attacks.
 3. The **final four** contestants will perform **Jiju-ippou Kumite** (semi-free sparring), same as above.
 4. In all categories of sparring, the defender must use blocking techniques prior to counter attacking. One out of the four counter attacks **must** be performed using a different technique.
 5. In both types of kumite, **no** deceptive pre-actions are allowed (no feinting).
-

6. In the case of a tie, **left** attacks are applied.
7. For girls and boys, aged **12-14**, the following individual elimination matches, until the **final four**, is applied: **Jiyu-ippō Kumite** (semi-free sparring), using **right** attacks only (starting from left gedan-barai) – Jodan Oi-zuki, Chudan Oi-zuki, Chudan Mae-geri, Chudan Yoko-geri Kekomi.
8. The same procedures as stated in 4, 5 & 6 above shall be applied.
9. The **final four** contestants will perform **Jiyu Kumite** (free sparring).
10. For girls and boys **15 –17** all matches are **Jiyu Kumite**.
11. There shall be **no** junior team kumite events.

Senior Division Qualification

1. Senior Individual participation is **limited** to **four women** and **four men** per country in individual kata.
2. Senior women and men **must** be ranked ISKF brown and black belt.
3. Their ages at the time of the CKC karate championships **must** be **45** years and older.
4. Senior Individual and team kumite contestants must be between the ages of **45** to **55** years.
5. All women and men **must** be ISKF members in good standing. An ISKF Membership Card with the pertinent information must be submitted at registration.
6. Team kata and kumite are **limited** to **one three-woman** team and **one three-man** team.

Individual and Team Kata Rules

1. All **individual elimination** matches will be judged by the flag system, until the semi-finals **eight** competitors, using the following **Shitei Kata: Heian Nidan, Heian Sandan, Heian Yondan, Heian Godan, Tekki Shodan**.
2. The **individual semi-finals eight** contestants will be judged by flag system, until the final four competitors, using the following **Sentei Kata: Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Empi, Jion**.
3. The **final four** constants and team kata events will be judged by point system with the contestants' choice of **Tokui Kata** (free kata).
4. In the case of a **tie** in individual or team kata final matches, a different kata must be performed. If the rematch is tied again, the **lowest** score will be added. If the result is still tied, the **highest** score will be added. If deadlocked, a **third different kata** must be performed.
5. In the **team kata finals**, the same kata used in the eliminations may be performed again.
6. The top **four (4)** senior women's and men's team will advance to the finals.

Individual and Team Kumite Rules

1. All contestants **must** have their own mouth guards and white sparing gloves.
2. All adult kumite events are Jiyu Kumite.
3. The top **four (4)** senior women's and men's team will advance to the finals.

Adult Division

Qualification

1. Adult Individual participation is limited to four women and four men per country in individual kata and kumite.
2. Adult women and men **must** be ranked ISKF brown and black belt.
3. Their ages at the time of the CKC karate championships must be 18 to 44 years.
4. All women and men must be ISKF members in good standing. An ISKF Membership Card with the pertinent information **must** be submitted at registration.
5. **One three-woman** kata team and **one three-woman** kumite team per country is allowed.
6. **One three-man** kata team and **one five-man** kumite team per country is allowed.

Individual and Team Kata Rules

1. All **individual elimination** matches will be judged by the flag system, until the semi-finals sixteen competitors, using the following **Shitei Kata: Heian Nidan, Heian Sandan, Heian Yondan, Heian Godan, Tekki Shodan.**
2. The **individual semi-finals sixteen** contestants will be judged by flag system, until the final four competitors, using the following **Sentei Kata: Bassai-dai, Kanku-dai, Empi, Jion.**
3. The **final four** constants and **team kata** events will be judged by point system with the contestants' choice of **Tokui Kata** (free kata).
4. In the case of a **tie** in individual or team kata final matches, a different kata **must** be performed. If the rematch is tied again, the **lowest** score will be added. If the result is still tied, the **highest** score will be added. If deadlocked, a **third different kata** must be performed.
5. In the **team kata** finals, the same kata used in the eliminations may be performed again.
6. The **top four** (4) adult women's and men's team will advance to the finals.

Individual Kumite Rules

1. All contestants **must** have their own mouth guards and white sparing gloves.
2. All adult kumite events are Jiyu Kumite.
3. The top four (4) adult women's and men's team will advance to the finals.

Other Rules

1. All contestants **must** wear a clean, unmarked white karate Gi. Their country's flag may be placed on the left chest.
2. The Gi **must** be ISKF regulations Gi with the length of the sleeves falling about midway between the elbow and the wrist.
3. The pants length must fall about midway between the knee and the ankle.
4. Forearm and/or shin guards and sweat bands are **not** allowed.
5. Jewellery or sharp objects in the hair are **not** allowed.

Officials' Rules

1. The Tournament is an extension of dojo training and therefore the same basic rules shall apply.
2. Kihon Ippon Kumite and Jiyu Ippon Kumite are the same as in rank examination. The right attacks will be performed first and in the event of a tie, left attack.
3. Procedures for **Jiyu kumite elimination** matches are as follows:
 - After a hikiwake, sakidore ippon (first to score a wazaari or ippon in a two-minute time period) is applied. The referee will announce “**sakidori Ippon hajime**”.
4. For the **finals** the following shall apply:
 - After a hikiwake, sai-shiai is applied (rematch two-minutes and ippon). The referee will announce “**sai-shiai.....hajime**”
 - If hikiwake again, sakidori ippon is then applied. The referee will announce “**sakidori Ippon hajime**”.
5. Time is stopped only when the referee indicates jikan.
6. Degrees of contact:
 - Light – verbal caution. A point may or may not be awarded.
 - Medium – hansoku chui. A point may not be awarded.
 - Heavy – hansoku. If a competitor accumulates two team kumite hansoku, they **cannot** compete further in any other team kumite events.
